## Subcommittee Reports

### ACTIVITIES CHAIR: Elana:

- Elana reported that the Activities Committee did not meet this month, as there were not many planning tasks needed.
- She shared information about the **Christmas Day Event**, which will take place from **1–4 PM at Trinity Church**. The Activities Committee plans to order a premade holiday meal from Fry’s to ensure turkey and ham are included. It will be a **potluck**, so members are encouraged to bring a dish to share. There will also be a speaker. Volunteers may be needed to assist with setup.
- For **New Year’s Eve**, the church will remain open following the Candlelight meeting. The event will include games such as Twister and board games, offering a safe place for fellowship on the holiday.
- Elana shared that it has been a pleasure serving the Area over the last year. She described the position as challenging but beneficial to her recovery and expressed gratitude for being able to introduce new ideas and continue activities for the fellowship. She is now passing the torch to the next trusted servant.
- Elana **requested \$750** to cover supplies and preparation for both the Christmas and New Year’s events.
  - **Bailey:** “You’ll keep one budget and two events?”
  - **Elana:** Clarified that she will use the **\$750 total** to cover **both events** combined.

### H&I VICE CHAIR: Mark M.:

- Mark reported that he was not able to attend the most recent H&I Subcommittee meeting due to recovering from pneumonia. He noted that Bailey will be presenting the report from that meeting on his behalf.
- Mark also shared that the past three weeks have brought in a significant number of t-shirt design submissions, which the committee is very excited about and appreciative of.
- **Bailey:** Reported that she has been filling in as H&I Secretary. James has stepped down from his position. Most panels have been filled consistently; however, due to ongoing issues at DP, the panels there have been temporarily canceled until concerns are resolved. The committee continues to work on guideline reviews.
- **Bailey** encouraged members to consider H&I service, noting that it is a meaningful but low-commitment opportunity — even serving on one panel per month provides valuable support to addicts seeking recovery. There is a current need for jail and juvenile facility applicants.
- She also noted that all commitments will be up for renewal in January.

The final H&I Subcommittee meeting of the year will be held on **December 27th at 9:00 AM at Frozen Frannies**, during which voting will take place for the H&I t-shirt design submissions.

Granite Mountain Coordinator – Stephanie B: 11/3 42 addicts and 11/17 27 in attendance. 69 addicts total.

Hillside Coordinator – Jacob O: absent. I think still every other and panels filled??

Decision Point Coordinator – OPEN: Dave M - 43 total addicts this month, panel seems to be going well even with the split up way it is right now. Every date is labeled on the calendar to show if it is mens, womens, co -ed.

Royal Detox Coordinator – Dave M: 19 total addicts. Some Fridays are great and some are not. All panels were filled.

Juvi Coordinator – OPEN: Bailey G – Journey is no longer wanting us to come in bi weekly. They have switched their program and our message conflicts with what they are teaching the kids. They have requested we come in once at the end of each session during the week where they present outside resources. I requested we have an hour and

a half if possible. Our plan on 12/2 is to bring 4 of us in for an hour and a half panel and see how it goes and go from there. They would mean approximately 4-5 panels a year.

Regular Juvi panel was filled and is going on as normal.

Not sure how many, probably approximately 10 for the month give or take a few.

Prescott Jail Coordinator – Joe W: John D has passed his background check and orientation. His first meeting will be 11/25. Jail requires us to ask the guards if only pre-registrants are attending. This is just an extra layer of accountability, not a reflection of an incident due to us. We are not going to take attendance. I am unable to maintain the coordinator position at this time as I am working out of state. Felicia is wondering if John D will take the position over if he gets cleared and stating she was ok with that happening.

Stoneridge Coordinator – OPEN: Mark text - Stoneridge is going well with an average attendance of 5.
