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Discussion:

Holding this workshop allows us to become familiar with the changes being proposed for the World Service Conference later this year. I want our Area's voice to be heard.

Annette: We have a lot of new GSRs who may not fully understand the process.

Mo: I printed flyers for the workshop.

Sean-Michael: When do the responses need to be turned in?

Mo: They need to be submitted by March. If you don't bring them to me, you can submit them directly on the World website.

Annette: Asked for clarification regarding the flyer.

Mo: CAT is separate from CAR. We vote on CAR motions.

OPEN FORUM:

The Open Forum focused on whether maintaining a Merchandise Chair is necessary. Members discussed concerns about fundraising distracting from NA's primary purpose, the workload involved in managing merchandise, and storage and inventory issues. Several members noted that merchandise can help with visibility and a sense of belonging but agreed it is not a top priority for Area. Alternatives discussed included folding remaining merchandise responsibilities back into Activities, having the Chair and Vice Chair oversee sales temporarily, or simply selling existing inventory without forming a subcommittee. It was noted that previous merchandise subcommittee participation was minimal. Overall, the discussion emphasized keeping processes simple, using existing inventory responsibly, and ensuring that energy and resources remain focused on carrying the message.

Discussion:

Mo: I know it's in our policy to have a Merchandise Chair, but I'm questioning whether that is a necessary position.

Annette: Fundraising can sometimes distract from our primary purpose and become more about business than the message. If we need to raise funds, that's fine, but I don't think it's a necessary position unless there is a clear financial need.

Mo: I'm also concerned about the amount of work involved—having leftover merchandise, finding storage, and managing inventory. It's nice to have, but I'm questioning if that's where our energy needs to go.

Trent: I agree it's not necessary. It's nice for visibility and has been around for years, and the last design was really nice and sold well. It helps people feel a part of, like with sweatshirts or T-shirts, but it's not our number one priority. It really comes down to willingness.

Aleena: My understanding is that merchandise used to be part of Activities before it became its own position. It might be helpful to look back at 2024 when we didn't have merch and see how we did financially. The goal isn't to make money like a business, but to ensure the Area survives financially so we can continue carrying the message to the addict who still suffers.

Kevin: We still have remaining merchandise from last year. We could piggyback that onto Activities and sell what we have to sustain us until someone is willing to step up.

Vincent: We originally split the position off from Activities because Activities was very labor-intensive, and this was meant to relieve some of that burden.

Trent: We need to pay attention to upcoming events and continue selling merchandise if we have it. Eventually we'll sell out. Since we don't currently have a Merchandise Chair, this task could fall to the Chair and Vice Chair for now.

Kevin: Would anyone be willing to form a subcommittee without a chair just to keep it going?

Aleena: When we had a merchandise subcommittee before, attendance was very low—only one meeting last year. I don't think it's necessary. Who can realistically commit to that?

Kevin: We can make decisions without a subcommittee.

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Trent: We don't want to take up valuable Area time. If people want to keep a Merchandise Chair, it would need to be handled outside of Area. We could get a list of interested names. Things have been simplified—we don't have to complicate them.

Aleena: Realistically, there isn't much decision-making involved. There is leftover merchandise, and someone can sell what we have.

Merchandise is currently stored in the storage unit with inventory.

Mo: I want us to have a healthy discussion about this.
